What can local businesses do to prevent the spread of hepatitis A?

- 1. Get vaccinated
- 2. Wash hands
- 3. Disinfect restrooms and surfaces (see flyer for disinfecting instructions)

1. VACCINATION

Encourage employees to get the hepatitis A vaccine. Vaccinations are covered by insurance with no co-pay. Employees who do not have insurance can call (831) 454-4114 or visit <u>www.santacruzhealth.org/HepA</u> to find locations for free vaccination clinics.

2. HANDWASHING

Employees should thoroughly wash their hands and arms with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds; thoroughly rinse with clean running water and properly dry hands and arms in all the following instances:

- Immediately before handling food.
- After using the toilet.
- After handling money.
- After coughing, sneezing, smoking, eating or drinking.

- After cleaning or housekeeping.
- After handling soiled equipment or utensils/tableware.
- Before putting on disposable gloves or touching your face.

Ensure handwashing signs are posted in appropriate locations.
