## **Hospital Readmission Rates-Adults**

## Introduction

Federal Managed Care require County MHP's to monitor readmission rates of psychiatric hospitalizations.

- The County monitors re-hospitalization of Medi-Cal beneficiaries.
- The County tracks re-hospitalizations within 30, 60 and 90 days of discharge from initial hospitalizations.
- The County Tracks the total number of re-hospitalizations per beneficiary per quarter.

Re-hospitalizations for Adults

Results for FY14-15 & FY 15-16

**Description:** The MHP tracks the number of days between the initial discharge from a psychiatric hospitalization and re-hospitalization of the same client. Goal is readmission rate no higher than 20.8%. **Frequency:** Reported quarterly, available approximately 4 weeks after the end of each quarter.

**Calculation:** Numerator: Number of Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are re-hospitalized by date intervals: 30, 60, 90 days. N= 64 FY15-16 N= 98 FY14-15

Denominator: Number of Medi-Cal beneficiaries hospitalized. FY15-16 N = 252 Readmission Rate – 25% FY14-15 N = 283- Readmission Rate – 35%
