California Reportable Disease Information Exchange (CalREDIE) is the California Department of Public Health's (CDPH)

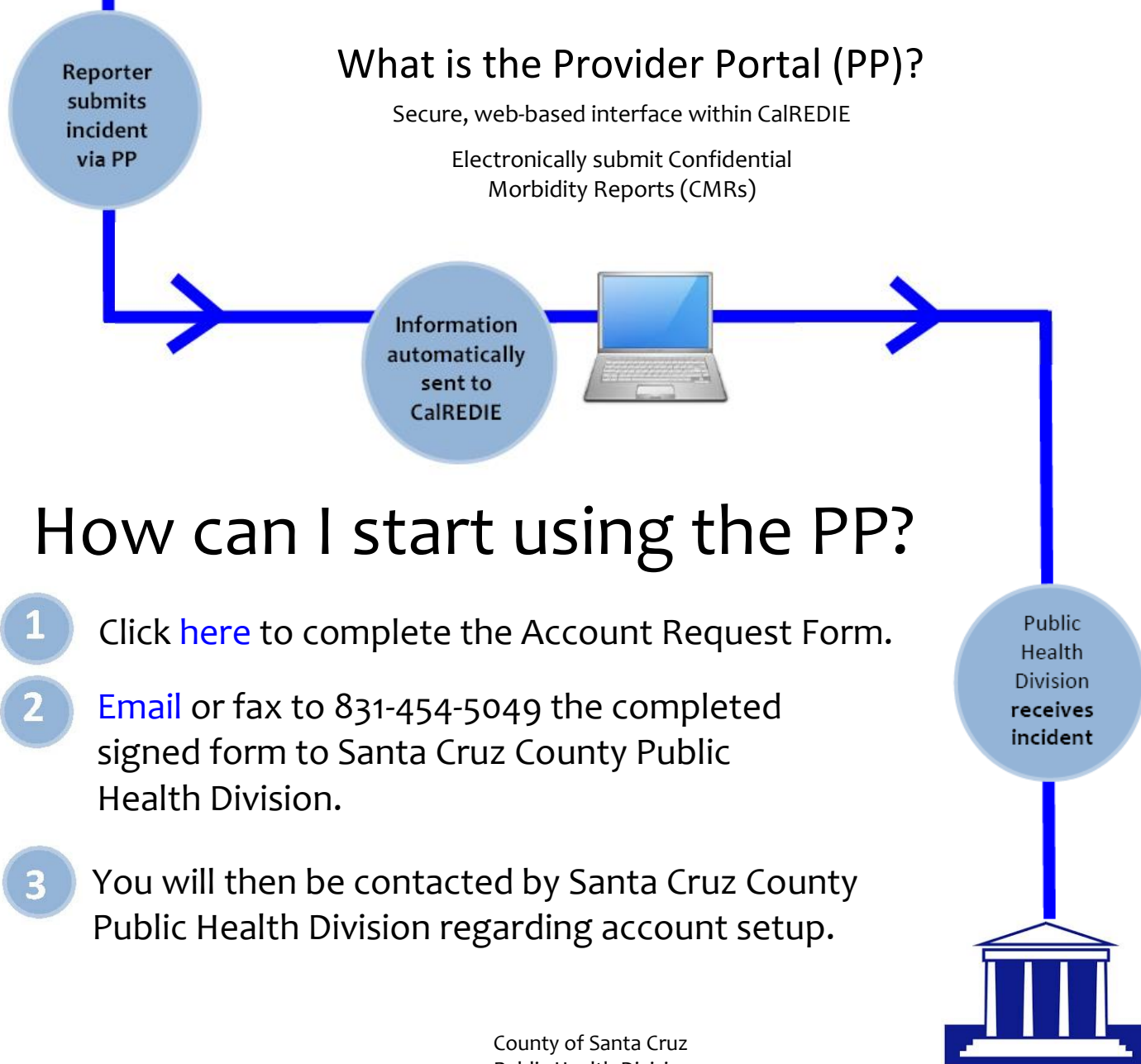
communicable disease reporting and surveillance system of record.
