COVID-19 Vaccines & Testing for Agricultural Workers

Who can get vaccinated?

Everyone 5 years of age and older can get a COVID-19 vaccine.

I had my vaccine. Can I get a booster?

All people ages 12 and older can get a booster shot to maintain protection.

When can I receive my booster?

- At least **2 months** after the first **Johnson & Johnson** shot
- At least **5 months** after the **Pfizer** or **Moderna series**



The vaccine is FREE. You do

NOT need to be a U.S. citizen or have health insurance.
