Types of Birth Control



Pi

A pill taken daily



Inserted by a medical provider. Effective for 3-10 years.



Sho

A shot someone gets every 3 months by a medical provider.



Implan

Inserted by a medical provider in the arm. Effective for up to 3 years.



Ring

A plastic ring someone will insert into the vagina and replace monthly.



Patch:

A sticker someone wears on their skin that is replaced weekly.



External/Internal Condom:

A barrier someone wears. (Prevents pregnancy & STIs)



Emergency Contraception:
A pill someone can take 0-5 days after unprotected sex to prevent pregnancy.
(condom breaks, missed birth control pill, etc.)
