


# It's Important to Get Your Second Dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine



It takes **TWO** doses of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine to be fully protected. Don't take chances with your health. It's safe, effective, and free!

## Fully vaccinated people can do more things.

You can visit other vaccinated people without a mask. You can travel in the U.S. without testing or quarantining. Don't miss out as restrictions lift.



## Getting fully vaccinated helps to open our schools and businesses.

As more people get vaccinated, it builds community-wide protection. The sooner that happens, the sooner we can all get back to our normal lives.



## It's not too late!

Don't worry if you missed the recommended schedule for a second dose. You can get your second dose up to six weeks (42 days) after your first.



## Side effects are minor.

You may have a fever, chills or body aches after a second dose. These are normal and usually only last a day or two.



## Frequently Asked Questions

### Do I need to get the same brand as my first vaccine?

Yes. If you don't remember what brand you received, talk to your healthcare provider.

### Do I need to return to the same place for my second dose?

No. You can go where it is easy for you.

### What if I lost my vaccination card?

Contact your first vaccine provider, or regular healthcare provider, to get a replacement card.

If they can't help you, contact the California Immunization Registry (CAIR) at <https://cairweb.org>.

If you enrolled in V-safe after your first dose, you can access your vaccine information here.
